BYLAW NO. 5

## A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Resort Village of Alice Beach, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
  - a. "public highway" means any street, lane or public highway within the village, but does not include a provincial highway therein as designated pursuant to the provisions of The Highway Act;
  - b. "vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Vehicles Act.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 30 kilometres per hour on a public highway within the limits of the village.
3. Sec. 2 shall not apply to the operators of fire engines or fire department apparatus or to vehicles being operated by law enforcement officers or to the operators of ambulances.
4. Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the village.
