BYLAW NO. 5

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Resort Village of Alice Beach, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:

a. "public highway" means any street, lane or public highway within the village, but does not include a provincial highway therein as designated pursuant to the provisions of The Highway Act;

o. "vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it

by The Vehicles Act.

- No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greate er speed than 30 kilometres per hour on a public highway within the limits of the village.
- 3. Sec. 2 shall not apply to the operators of fire engines or fire department apparatus or to vehicles being operated by law enforcement officers or to the operators of ambulances.
- 4. Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the
