BYLAW 54 – 13

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE AND OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES (ATV's)

Pursuant to *The All Terrain Vehicles Act*, the Council of the Resort Village of Alice Beach, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "All Terrain Vehicle (ATV) Bylaw"
2. Definitions:

For the purpose of this bylaw, the following terms and words shall have the following meaning:

- a) **"all terrain vehicle"** means self-propelled vehicle that:
 - i) Is designed primarily for the movement of people or goods on unprepared surfaces; and
 - ii) Has wheels in contact with the ground;and includes:
 - iii) An all terrain cycle (quads) and
 - iv) Golf cartsbut does not include:
 - v) A restricted use motorcycle;
 - vi) A mini-bike;
 - vii) A snowmobile as defined in *The Snowmobile Act*;
 - viii) An agricultural implement or special mobile machine as defined in *The Traffic Safety Act*; or
 - ix) Any vehicle that is required to be registered pursuant to *The Traffic Safety Act*.
- b) **"highway"** means a road, parkway, driveway, square or place designated and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area and does not include a provincial highway within the municipality as designated pursuant to the provisions of *"The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997"*.
- c) **"day"** means the period between six o'clock in the forenoon and nine o'clock in the afternoon on the same day.

3. Purpose:

The purpose of this bylaw is to allow for the use of any/or all classes of all terrain vehicles as defined on the travelled portion of all highways within the boundaries of the Resort Village of Alice Beach as indicated on appendix "A" (excepting provincial highways and public reserves) during the day only.

4. Every person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction under the General Penalty Bylaw #5/95.
5. This bylaw comes into force and takes effect when adopted by Council and appendix "A" is attached.
