**WEBSITE-** A reminder to everyone to log into the website regularly. This website contains valuable information and is our venue to provide this information to our residents, such as minutes, bylaws, notices and upcoming events. It is your way of staying informed.

**BOAT LAUNCH-** Parking areas have been designated for residents and overflow for visitors. Residents of RVAB are reminded to place your permit on the dash of your vehicle. You may pick up a pass/permit at 151 Marine Dr. We have started ticketing for non-compliance.

**COMPOST PILE-** The compost area will be turned and spread on a continuous schedule to eliminate a fire hazard. **PLEASE**, no plastic bags, containers, branches or garbage with your grass and leaves.

**GARBAGE DISPOSAL CONTAINERS-** These containers are for household garbage only. No construction materials please. Your assistance in monitoring abuse will be welcomed. **ANIMAL CARCASSES ARE STRICKLY PROHIBITED.**

**BYLAW ENFORCEMENT-** The bylaws are on the website. If you have any questions about whether you may be in violation of any bylaws, please contact any member of council or our administrator.

**Disposal of Excavation Material-** Dirt and rocks from excavation within our resort village will no longer be allowed to be disposed of within the village. You may contact any member of council for suggestions of an alternate dumping site.

**Rodent Control-** There have been several incidents of skunks, raccoons, and stray cats throughout RVAB this summer and fall. Marly Dorosh has offered to deal with situations that residents themselves may not be able to rectify. He is a licensed trapper and has the knowledge and capability to deal with these unwanted animals. He may be reached at 306-681-4117. He will be charging a small fee for each individual situation.

**RESTRICTIONS ON ATV/GOLF CARTS-** The village has a bylaw designating allowed use of ATV's and golfcarts. The area these vehicles can be operated are on designated streets ONLY. Village property, parks, green space, and ditches are in violation of the bylaw. This has become a problem within our village and we will be asking our bylaw officer and RCMP to monitor this abuse more closely in the future. Any abuses witnessed can be reported to those authorities.

**AED –** The Resort Village of Wee Too Beach has had an AED installed in their community garage (corner of Lakeshore Drive and Highway 733B). The AED that was donated by the Sarnia First Responders has been registered with the PAD program and is accessible by calling 911. 911 will provide details for those needing access to the unit.
